P-1 is a two-seat reconnaissance aircraft created in 1924 in the USSR on the basis of the DH-9a aircraft, in the design bureau of N.N. Polikarpov. The design of the R-1 was not a direct copy of the British prototype but was an adaptation of one of the most successful aircraft of the First World War for this purpose to the capabilities of the nascent Soviet aircraft industry. R-1 became the first large-scale aircraft in the USSR, produced from 1924 to 1932 at two factories in Moscow and Taganrog. The total production of modifications R-1 (reconnaissance), R-2 (training version), MP-1 (float version), and P-1 (unarmed civilian version) amounted to 2751 copies. The first cars were equipped with the American Liberty-12 engine and since 1925 they installed its Soviet copy M-5. Aircraft of this type played an important role in the formation of the Red Army Air Force. The R-1 was used by the Soviet Air Force in the Sino-Soviet conflict on the CER in 1929. Civilian versions of the R-1 and R-2 participated in the international flight Moscow-Beijing-Tokyo in 1925. The R-1 was in service until the mid-1930s.
