NOTES

Because of the limitations of the vacuum moulding process, it is impractical to provide wheels, props, engine and struts.

It is suggested that the wheels, prop & engine be used from the Revell Fokker E 111 or other suitable parts from the spares box.
Struts can be made up from surplus plastic sheet or sprue.



KIT # 8 MORANE-SAULNIER 'L'



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out parts & sand edges flat.
- 2. Cement profile into fuselage half leaving an edge for locating opposite half.
- 3. Cement 2 pieces of plastic inside fuselage half, top & bottom, forward of profile, leaving edge protruding.
- 4. Cement fuselage halves together & detail cockpit. Fill seams with body putty & sand smooth.
- 5. Cement 2 laminations of plastic into wing top half as stiffener, cement wing halves together.
- 6. Sand leading & trailing edges & drill holes for rigging & struts.
- 7. Cement rudder & elevator halves together.
- 8. Make up cabane & u/carriage struts.
- 9. Insert front cabane struts through holes in wing & attach to fuselage.
- 10. Cement rear cabane strut into place & struts from rear of engine cowling to wing, also diagonal strut from rear centre section to top of front cabane struts.
- 11. Cut out bottom of cowling, cement rotary engine from spares box to nose & attach cowling in place.
- 12. Cement u/carriage & elevator in place.
- 13. Complete painting, attach decals.
- 14. Cement rudder into position, attach prop & wheels from spares box.
- 15. Rig completed model.
