




Underwing view for 'White 9'.












•Note: The gun trough gaps on decal G1 must be painted black.

"Black 3" Fw 190 A-6 2/JG 1 W. Nr. unknown Pilot: Thought to be Knight's Cross holder Lt. Anton-Rudolf Piffer 2/JG 1

Pifffer was one of the Jagdwaffe's bomber Expertens with 19 bombers shot down and 26 total victories. He was shot down and killed by U.S. fighters 17 June 1944.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 74 Gray Green, Mottled 74/75. Black 3 outlined in Red.

Spinner: Yellow/Red. Rudder: White. Red/Black checkered cowl; red appears to be slightly faded. (The checks supplied are scaled to

Tamiya F-8 kit 48th and Hasegawa 72nd. Alternate checks are included to fit other available kits.) Undercowling appears to be Yellow.

"Black 2" Fw 190 A-6 2/JG 1 W. Nr. unknown Pilot: unknown 2/JG 1

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 74 Gray Green. Black 2 outlined in Red.

Spinner: half White, other half Red/Yellow. Rudder: White. Red/Black checkered cowl; red appears to be slightly faded. (The checks

supplied are scaled to Tamiya F-8 kit 48th and Hasegawa 72nd. Alternate checks are included to fit other available kits.)

"Black 1" Fw 190 A-5 W. Nr. 7328 Pilot: Hptm. Dietrich Wickop 5/JG 1 Staffelkapitän Date: May 1943

Hptm. Wickop lost 6 May 1943 by 50-60 P-47's.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 74 Gray Green.

Spinner: Black or 70 Black Green with White tip. Note interesting Eagle under cockpit, both sides. Undercowling Yellow.

National Markings: standard

Stencilling: standard

"White 9" Fw 190 A-7 W. Nr. 430965 Pilot: Hptm. Alfred Grislawski Staffelkapitän 1/JG 1

Grislawski is holder of the Knight's Cross with Oak Leaves. He first served with JG 52, JG 50, JG 1, and later JG 53. He flew 800 missions and achieved 133 victories including 18 bombers.

Flash suppressors on MG 131's upper cowl. Outboard pitot tube like A-8. Armored quarter panel on windshield.

Colors: Undersurfaces, 76 Light Blue. Uppersurfaces, 75 Gray Violet, 74 Gray Green.

Spinner: White. RVD band: Red. Red undercowl. Yellow underwing tips.

National Markings: standard

Stencilling: standard

Special Instructions: Use copper tubing or plastic rods with the ends drilled out to make the flash suppressors for the upper cowl MG 131's.

Overall diameter should be slightly larger than MG 131 barrels.
