The McDonnell Douglas DC-9 is a twin-engine, single-aisle jet airliner.

It was first manufactured in 1965 with its maiden flight later that year.

The DC-9 was designed for frequent, short flights. The final DC-9 was delivered in October 1982, The -30 was the definitive series with 662 produced, accounting for about 60% of production.




