



The Curtiss P-36 Hawk (Hawk Model 75) is an American-designed and built fighter aircraft of the 1930s and 40s. It was one of the first of a new generation of combat aircraft—a sleek monoplane design making extensive use of metal in its construction and powered by the Pratt & Whitney R-1830 radial engine. The Curtiss P-36A was exported to many countries such as France, the Netherlands, Norway, and the UK and was active in each front in World War II. The only combat by U.S.-operated P-36s took place during the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. Five of the 39 P-36A Hawks at Pearl Harbor were able to take off during the attack and were credited with shooting down two Japanese Mitsubishi A6M2 Zeros for the loss of one P-36, thereby scoring U.S. aerial victories that were among the first of the Second World War.
