
## DASSAULT MIRAGE IIIR


The French Dassault Mirage III is one of history's classic aircraft. First flown in the mid 1950's, the delta-winged Mirage began service with the French Armee de l'Air in 1957. Compared to today's aircraft, the Mirage III is far outmoded and difficult to fly, but it still serves on, and has proven to be quite efficient in several roles.

The Mirage III is an inexpensive and effective fighting machine, despite its obsolesence. It has provided an effective fighting machine for many small nations because of its simplicity of construction and relatively low cost.

One version of the Mirage III is fitted with a large bay in the nose and mounts a battery of cameras for photo-recon missions. This variant of the French jet is designated Mirage IIIR. For over twenty years this model of the Mirage was the only tactical-reconniassance aircraft in the French air force.

The Mirage IIIR has a wingspan of 27 feet and it is nearly 50 feet long. It is powered by a single SNECMA Atar 9 with more than 13,000 1bs of thrust. This gives the plane a maximum speed of 863 mph, or Mach 1.14, at sea level, and 1,460 mph, (Mach 2.2) at altitude.
